#### About the Ken & Lee's Crew Fishing Team

Ken Conrad was diagnosed with pancreatic cancer in September 2015. Looking for ways to support his fight, his 'crew' of friends and family focused on his love of deep-sea fishing.

After he passed away, we renamed his boat the 'Ken's Crew', painted it pancreatic cancer purple, and got permission to add the Pancreatic Cancer Action Network (PANCAN) logo to the stern. We started selling 'Ken's Crew' merchandise, hosting oyster roasts, and entering fishing tournaments to raise money and awareness. In November 2018 Ken's wife, Lee Conrad, passed away from leukemia, which was another gut punch but hasn't affected our resolve. Instead we added leukemia orange to our merchandise, revised the logo to 'Ken & Lee's Crew', and doubled down on our fundraising.



As of May 2022, the Crew has raised over \$150,000 to further cancer research, including over \$60,000 raised as part of the 2022 Reelin for Research Tournament.



#### What is 'Reelin' for Research'?

Reelin' for Research is a year-round fundraising effort benefiting the UNC Children's Hospital and childhood cancer research that culminates each year with a one-day fishing tournament in Morehead City, NC. To date, over 5.2 million dollars has been raised to help LAND A CURE for childhood cancer!

Each year, \$100,000 of the money raised goes into the Tony Montana Fellowship Fund at UNC Children's Hospital which is then awarded to a physician specializing in childhood cancer research. The remainder of the funds are placed into an endowment with the purpose of eventually funding the fellowship into perpetuity.
